Continuing education for our entire staff is vitally important to maintaining the quality of our programs. Not only that, it is an ongoing requirement of the Agency for Persons with Disabilities in order to maintain our certification with the State of Florida.

On April 16, our staff joined together for a day of education covering several important topics to better equip us to serve our individuals. We started the morning with a session on how behavior itself is a form of communication, and the importance of adapting our own communication styles for best mutual understanding. We also participated in an online training session geared toward equipping our individuals and activating our communities. Next, the FL Dept. of Elder Affairs "Alzheimer's Disease and Dementia Awareness" webinar was a great tool for helping our staff learn some of the intricacies of conditions that, research has shown, affect our I/DD population at a higher rate, and at an earlier age.

Changing gears, we participated in a virtual session with our record-keeping software provider who helped us add to our knowledge base of the many features built into the program. Maintaining accurate information is key to quality communication among our staff, our families, and support coordinators.

While we understand that closing the program for a day twice a year can be inconvenient to our individuals and their families, we're thankful for the understanding of how important this truly is.


