### **Message from CEO**

We often think of summer as the time to slow down and relax, but our important advocacy work never takes a break.

With the current bill that has made it's way through the US House, The Arc of the United States urges the Senate to reject \$715 billion in cuts to Medicaid and SNAP that threaten access to health care and essential services. These cuts will impact all people covered by the Medicaid program, including many of our Arc of Volusia participants.

This bill also prescribes new administrative barriers that require people with coverage through Medicaid expansion to renew their eligibility two times a year, instead of once, which will increase the risk that people with disabilities will incorrectly lose coverage.

Next, the Senate must take up the bill. The Arc urges Congress to reject this proposal and protect Medicaid and SNAP. These programs are not optional. They are how people with disabilities live in their homes, care for their families, and survive each day.
